Narrative

Q1 has delivered on the core promise of the programme: every girl in our four active schools now has her first twelve-month supply of dignity kits on hand, and every Girls' Health Club we revitalised is holding weekly peer sessions. Teacher training is running two weeks ahead of the original plan, with ten of thirty teachers already completed.

The biggest challenge this quarter was distance — two of our Samburu East schools require a four-hour round trip from Maralal, and the short rains in February made one road impassable for a week. We are building a buffer stock at each Girls' Health Club to absorb that kind of disruption going forward.

What your support has funded this quarter. Every KES 660,000 represents one school served for a full year. Your donations this quarter translated directly into 1,440 dignity kits delivered to 120 girls and 10 teachers trained to sustain the work beyond us.
